

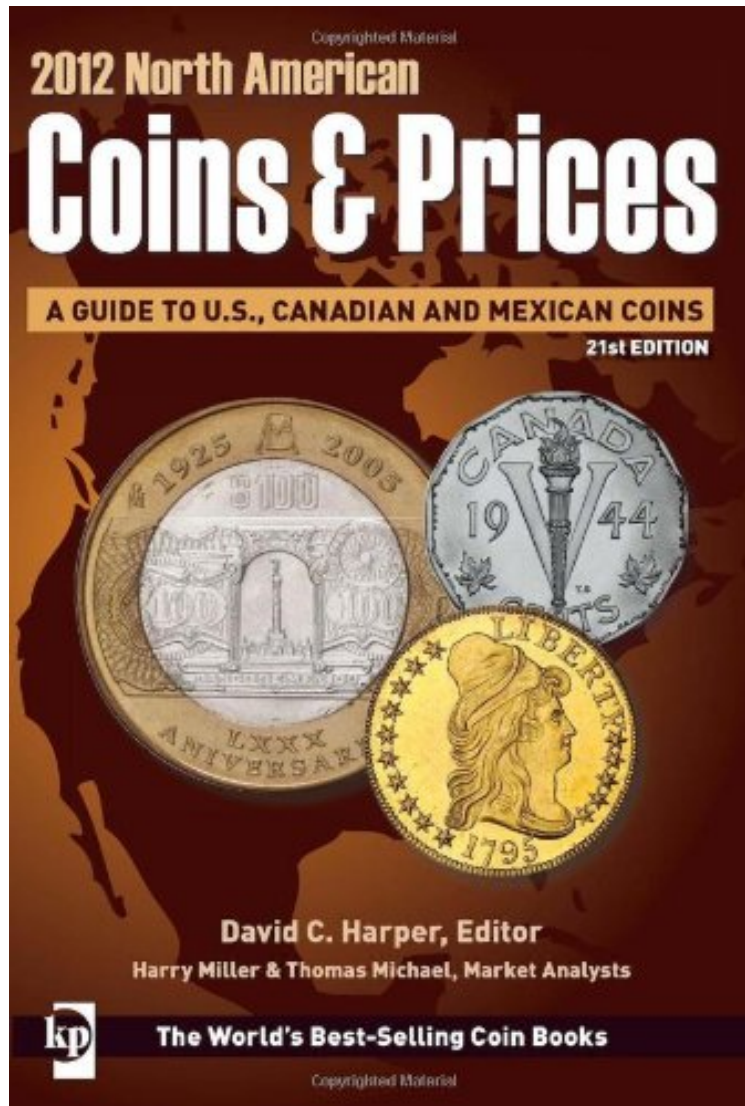

Some reviews have pointed out that the prices are not current for coins made from precious metals. That is understandable given the volatility of the precious metals markets. For example, silver was selling for about \$6 per ounce in January 2004, it peaked at around \$45 per ounce in the spring of 2011 and recently has been holding fairly steady at about \$28 per ounce. So I use this publication for the information it provides on each North American

coin. Most useful to me is the total weight in grams, the fineness (percentage of precious metal), the precious metal content in ounces and, most importantly, the diameter of the coin. I'm a type collector, so I am interested in, for example, which coin will fit in the 40 mm page of my Dansco album. You would be surprised to find out how difficult it can be to find the diameter of some coins, even on the Internet. I recommend this book highly. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
