It might have been useful for a beginner when it was published in 1993 but is outdated now. It attempts to cover too much in one book such as metallic and shot shell reloading, casting bullets and building wooden bullet storage boxes and trays! It also covers many now obsolete and one off cartridges that might interest a niche group of re-loaders.Plus, it dedicates and entire chapter to an obsolete programmable calculator used to figure bullet trajectories and velocities. Maybe it was useful in the early 90s but computers today can handle most of what a reloader needs regarding reloading data and bullet information. A simple Google search finds more data than any book can cover.If you keep old books and manuals for historical reference this might be useful but I figured I wasted my money.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
