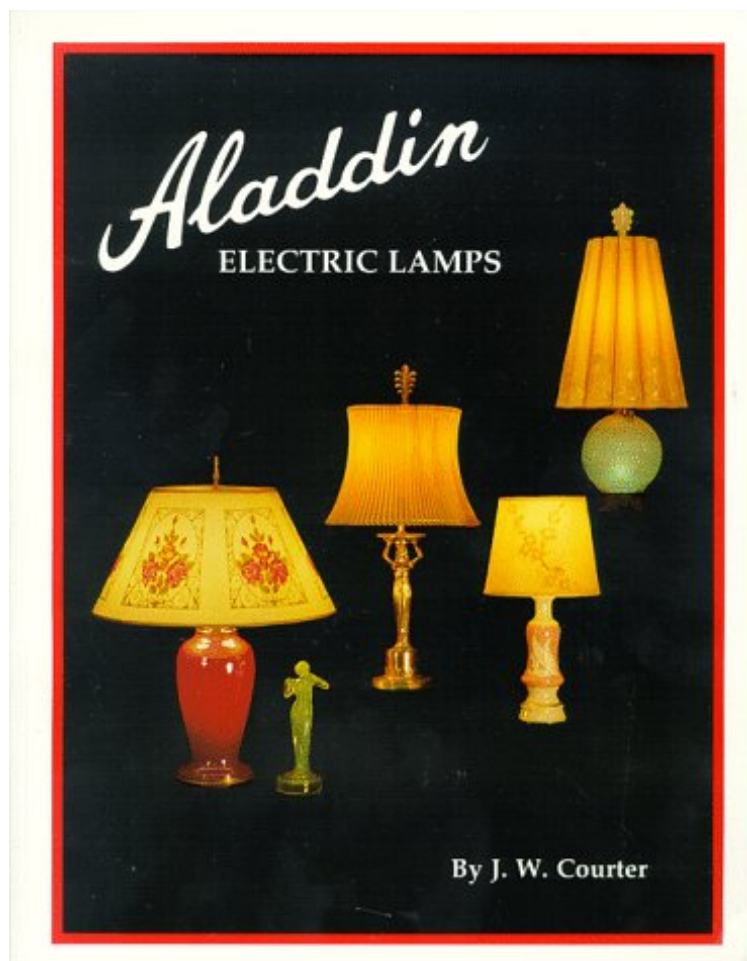

It is the companion to the full size 8 3/4" x 11 1/4" x 3/4" book, "Aladdin Electric Lamps" by J.W. Courter. Which is his book that focuses on electric lamps, copyrighted and released in 1987. There has been a total of 5 price guides as companions to "Aladdin Electric Lamps". They are; 1. Aladdin Electric Lamps Price Guide #1, copyright 1989. Completely black and white photos. 2. Aladdin Electric Lamps Collectors Manual Price Guide #2, copyright 1993. Black white, except for 9 pages of colored photographs. 3. Aladdin Electric Lamps Collectors Manual Price Guide #3, copyright 1997. Exactly the same photos and information as #2, but with some updated values. 4. Aladdin Electric Lamps Collector's Manual Price Guide #4, copyright 2002. Completely black white photos except for the inside of the front back covers. 5. Aladdin electric Lamps Collectors Manual Price Guide #5, copyright

2006. Completely black white except for inside of the front back covers. ALL the electric price guides give you a beginning idea about Aladdin Lamps, parts and shades, alacite and velvex glassware, and much more. However it is really necessary, for the pricing aspect, more so with electric than kerosene, to own the 'big' book, or get it from your local library. It is continually needed for reference. These price guides for Aladdin electric's often give only a number to identify a lamp, and then the page number where you'll find the photo of the lamp in the big book. Without the big book you would OFTEN have no clue what lamp the value is referring to. Footnote: NOT to be confused with the first book Courter ever published on Aladdin lamps in 1971 that contained information on both categories, electric and kerosene mantle Aladdin lamps. That book "Aladdin the magic name in lamps" has had multiple printings by Wallace-Homestead Co, Des Moines, Iowa, since its first copyright year of 1971. And also has had numerous price guides as well. The 1983 guide I have states it is the ninth, and I'm sure there were others until the first price guide covering only electric was copyrighted and released in 1989. Courter had greatly expanded his research and divided the categories. And in 1987 he had published his second book about Aladdin lamps titled, "Aladdin electric lamps" from Plain Talk Publishing, Des Moines, Iowa. This book focuses on Aladdin electric lamps, and is the book the above 5 price guides are a companion to. In 1997 he had published his third book about Aladdin lamps titled, "Aladdin the magic name in lamps" (stated on the spine is REVISED EDITION) from Image Graphics, Inc, Paducah, Kentucky, this book focuses on kerosene mantle lamps.
