

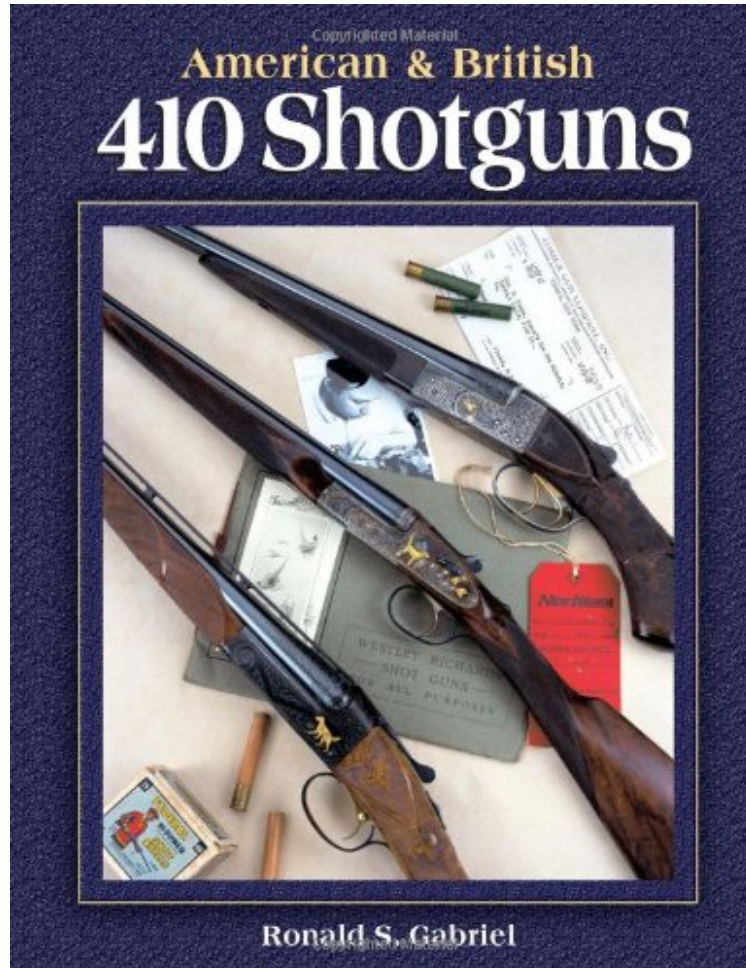

This book is purely for the high market collector, the very high-market collector, for someone considering to spend \$10,000 to \$100,000 on your 410ga. Half the book addresses British double barrels, Holland Holland, John Wilkes, Westley Richards, John Dickson, Boss, etc. The American half of the book covers LC. Smith, Parker Brothers, Ithaca doubles, and the lowly Winchester 21 - of course just the deluxe wood and engraved models in the \$25,000 to \$35,000 range. The Mossberg 410ga, Remington 410ga, etc. are never mentioned, as though anything under several grand never existed. If you are looking for a 410ga in the \$10,000 to \$100,000 range this book is for you. Do not buy this expecting to get info on a regular field gun in 410ga or something you may consider to purchase for your children.
