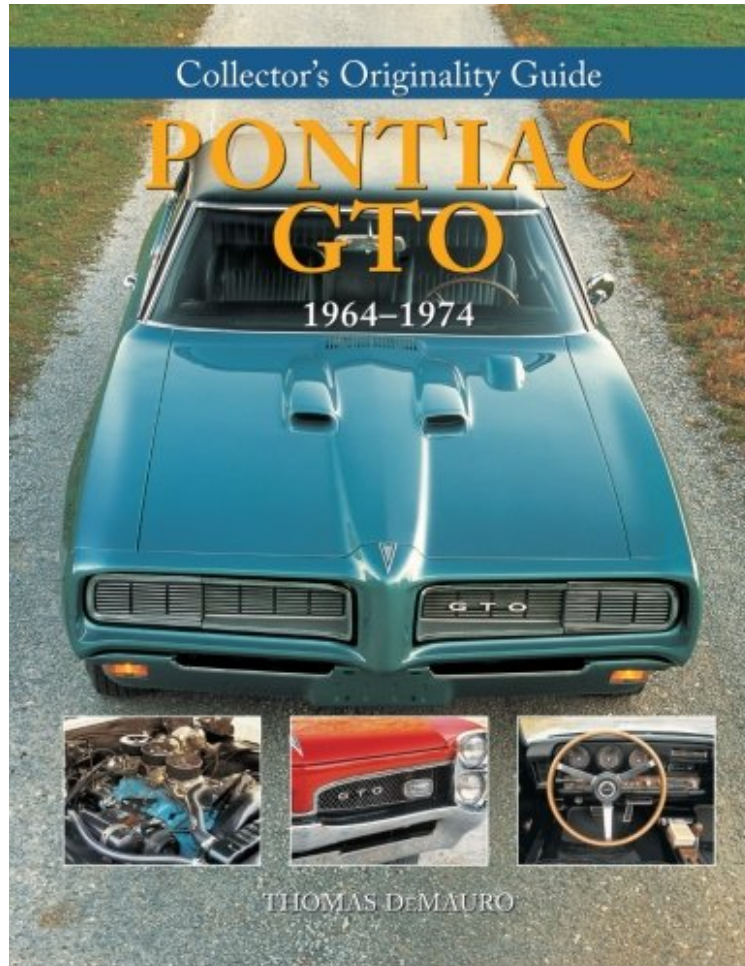

Even the appendix is stuffed with tons of facts and figures, not the least of which, are a VIN breakdown, assembly plant codes, cowl data tag breakdown, camshaft codes, transmission applications, production number breakdown and other minutia.
