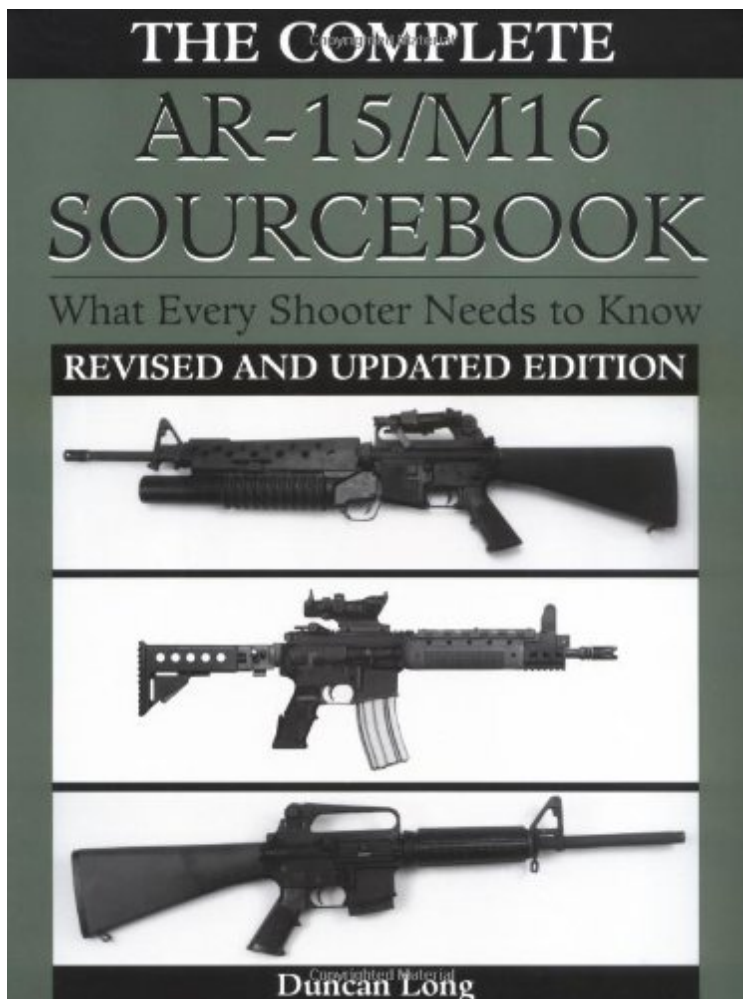

Some issues like the "danger of excessive headspace" are a little overdone but few people ever read Hatcher's Notebook to learn the truth about headspace.
