

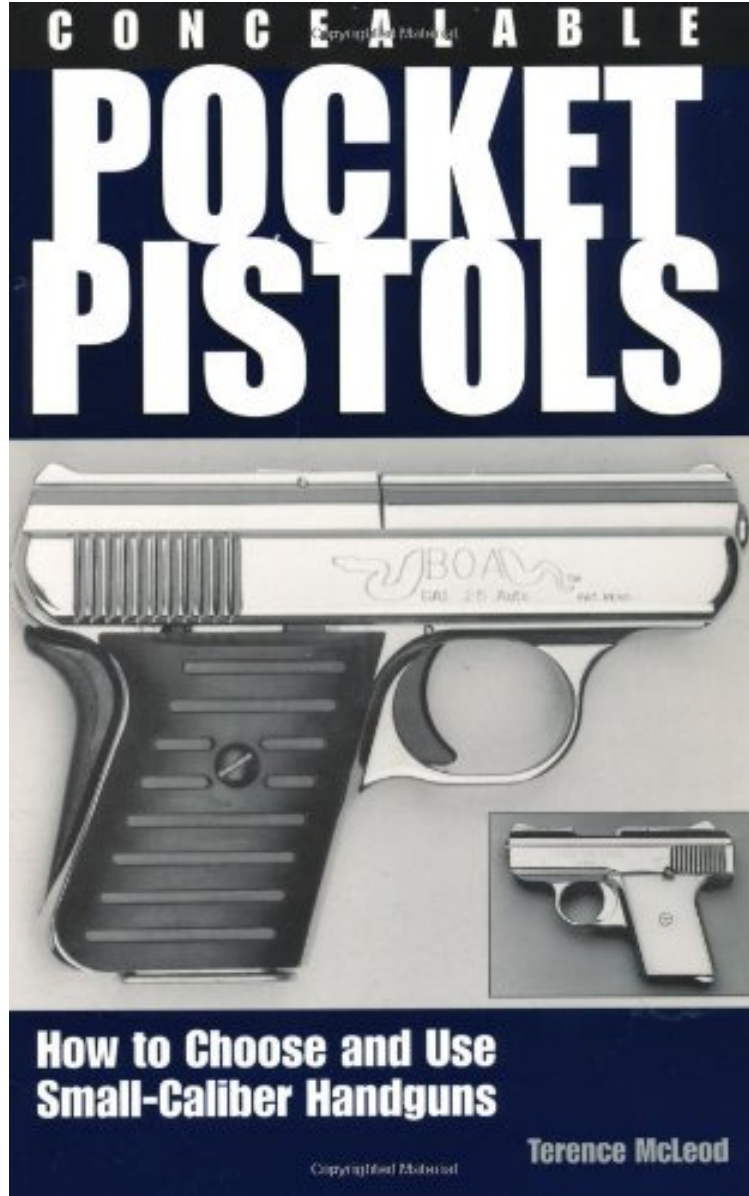

This book is very light on information that can't be quickly and easily found in a decent online article. In fact, I really think only about 15 of the 71 pages are worth reading. The rest of the book is filled with basic information and obvious statements. In addition, it often digresses into propagandizing and rants about gun control.
