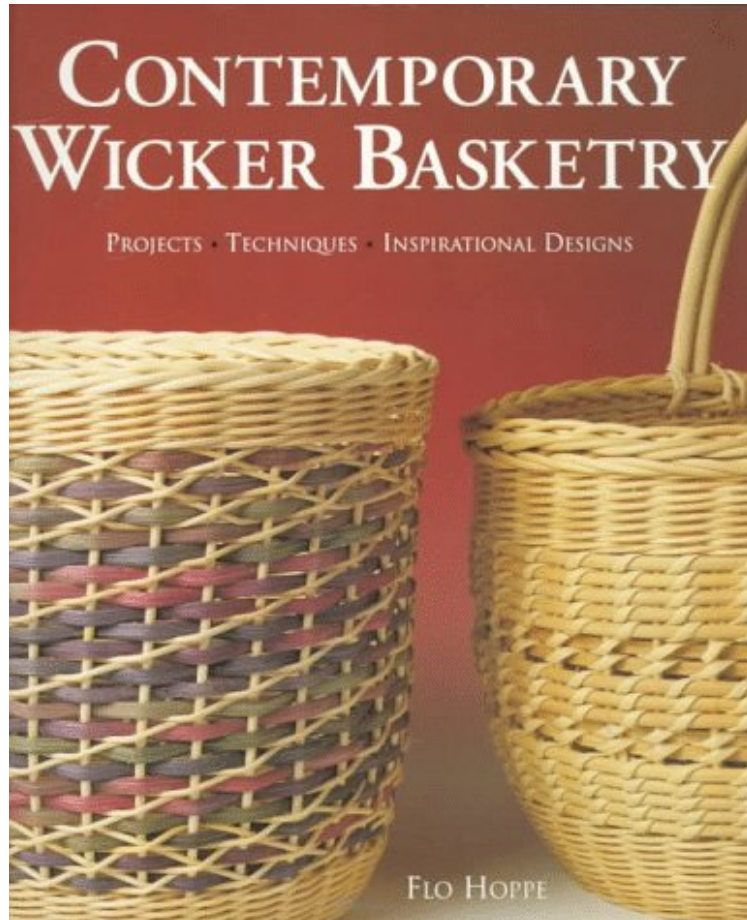

In this book for beginning basketmakers, Hoppe, a teacher of basketry, concentrates on reed, which is readily available and easily woven. The major part of the book covers the techniques of making basket components such as bases, lids, and handles.
