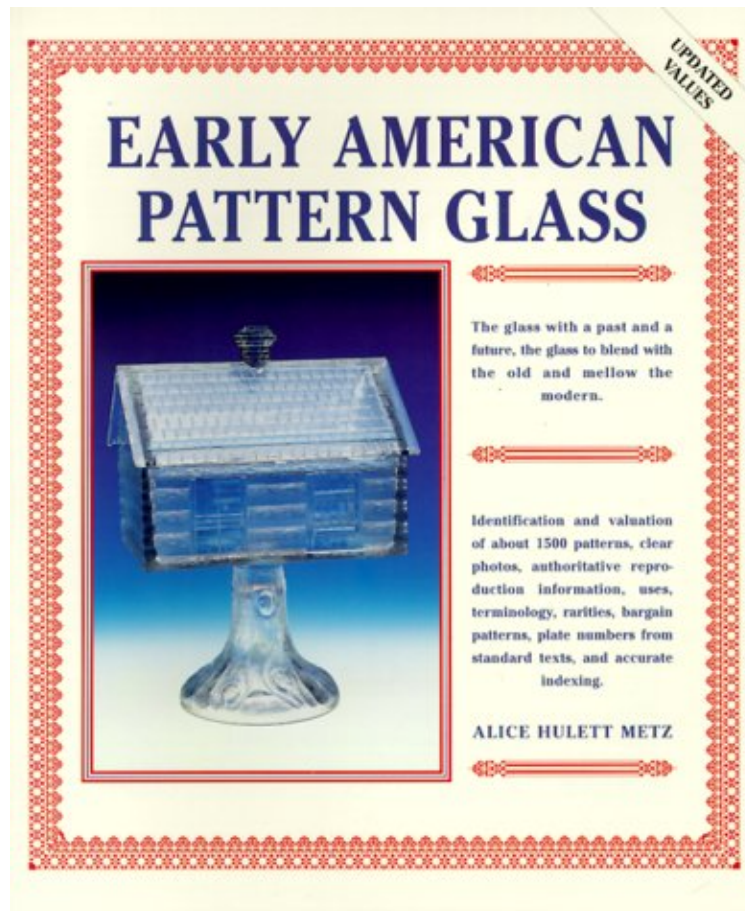

Dont buy it.By CustomerBy far the sloppiest and least informative book on Early American Pattern Glass I've ever read. Originally published in 1965 it's had no decent updates since other than a few instances of guesswork at valuation that is clearly not based in today's Antique Market reality. It has no table of contents, and no noticeable thought put into how the chapters (are there chapters?) are set up or arranged. It's simply a collection of one-off pieces of glass of various patterns that seem to be put together according to how the author ran across them in her wanderings. There is no reference to other pieces in the patterns she shows - only the piece she's actually found. More like a collection of her collection than a detailed reference work. And the photos, if you can call them that, are terrible. All black and white (which I expected) and so poorly done (probably due to repeated reprintings) - as if sketched with a dull pencil rather than actually lit properly and photographed with a camera that allows the use of focus. And to add insult to injury, almost every page contains a comment by the author about how much she knows, how much you need to study to be

anywhere like her, and annoyingly sugary sentences intended to be funny but end up instead being condescending and outdated in her Victorian passive-aggressive style. I have no idea why anyone would consider this a valuable reference. I bought it cheap and on sale and still think I was ripped off. I may try to resell it here on but I'd probably not sleep due to conscience if someone actually bought it.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
